<b>General Information</b>	The Tanzania Domestic Biogas Programme (TDBP) is a tripartite public-private partnership programme between the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs (DGIS), the Netherlands Development Organization (SNV) and Hivos. TDBP is hosted by the Centre for Agricultural Mechanization and Rural Technologies (CAMARTEC). TDBP aims at building a foundation for large scale commercial dissemination of domestic biogas technology in Tanzania using the Fixed Dome Modified-CAMARTEC digester design. The ultimate intention of the programme is to make biogas a mainstream and commercially available domestic energy source country-wide. The programme's initiation is based on the need to reap the benefits of biogas use, which have since been documented in the literature. These benefits range from health and living conditions improvement, environmental conservation, soil fertility improvement, reduction of greenhouse effect to creation of new job and business opportunities.
